


**CYBERPOINT INTERNATIONAL, A** computer security startup based in Baltimore, has been celebrated by Maryland politicians as a positive force in the community, invited to join U.S. trade missions in Poland and Romania, and even won a special export license from the State Department to advise the United Arab Emirates. As the *Washington Post* reported, the license was granted to develop defensive cybersecurity capabilities.

So why is Cyberpoint listed as a "partner" to Hacking Team, the Italian company under fire for selling spyware used by repressive regimes across the world?

## Isis: One year on

The seven wars in Muslim countries

#### Syria ===

Isis rules over 50 per cent of country though much of this is in scantily populated east. It has a serious rival in the shape of Jabhat al-Nusra, the official al-Qaeda affiliate, which dominates Syrian opposition movement in north-west Syria.

#### Iraq ===

Isis rules a third of the country and dominates the Sunni community. Despite US airstrikes it captured Ramadi, capital of Anbar province, on 17 May.

#### Afghanistan 🔽

Isis has established a fast growing affiliate as Taliban leadership splits on issues of peace and war. Weak Afghan government provides suitable environment for Isis.

#### Libya 🚾

With power in Libya divided between two rival governments and hundreds of militia groups, this is an ideal environment for Isis that has taken Sirte in central Libya and Derna in the east.

#### Yemen

Isis has established an affiliate that is already carrying out sectarian killings of those it deems apostates. It benefits from collapse of central state and Saudi air attacks on Yemen army, but al-Qaeda in Arabian Peninsula is also growing strongly.

#### Nigeria 🚺

Boko Haram has pledged allegiance to Isis and, though under pressure from Nigerian and Chadian armies, still operates in a swathe of territory in Nigeria, Chad, Niger and northern Cameroon.

#### Somalia 🔀

The absence of central government since 1991 opened the door to al-Shabab, the al-Qaeda linked movement that controls a large part of the country. Isis has been sending emissaries to it, seeking its allegiance in a country with ideal conditions for jihadis.







There were, however, some overpresent pro-IS terms. These included "Remaining" (*Baqiya*), the first half of the ISIS motto, and the hashtag #Islamic\_State\_is\_preparing\_for\_the\_liberation\_of\_the\_country\_of\_the\_two\_holy\_mosques, which refers to Saudi Arabia.

The GCC community-mentions network, with 59,116 users, is shown in Figure C.2. This is the largest Sunni community we examined and is mostly anti-ISIS, with 75 percent of users regularly using the Arabic term *Daesh* and only 8 percent using *Islamic State*. It has a very classic core/periphery structure, with many highly connected users in the center of the network and many user "chains" (very common in Twitter mention networks) on the periphery. There are a few prominent and potentially influential pro-ISIS users, but the majority of the core is made up of ISIS opponents.

Figure C.2 GCC Community Network Representation



#### DARKMATTER AND DEPARTURES

When Raven was created in 2009, Abu Dhabi had little cyber expertise. The original idea was for Americans to develop and run the program for five to 10 years until Emirati intelligence officers were skilled enough to take over, documents show. By 2013, the American contingent at Raven numbered between a dozen and 20 members at any time, accounting for the majority of the staff.

In late 2015, the power dynamic at the Villa shifted as the UAE grew more uncomfortable with a core national security program being controlled by foreigners, former staff said. Emirati defense officials told Gumtow they wanted Project Raven to be run through a domestic company, named DarkMatter.

Raven's American creators were given two options: Join DarkMatter or go home.

### Lessons Learned

- If it's too good to be true
- Vet your leadership
- If they take your passport, worry
- Always ask for printed and signed documentation
- Ask twice, hack once
- Remember your training
- Have an exit strategy
- Family is your most important asset
